

1 5. Dr. Bottiglione's records were sparse and poorly documented, and he did
2 not include an informed consent signed by the patient. His records also
3 failed to depict the treated areas appropriately.

4 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 5 1. The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and
6 over Dr. Bottiglione pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1401 *et seq.*
7 2. The conduct and circumstances described above in paragraphs 3
8 through 5 constitute unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-
9 1401(25), "Failing or refusing to maintain adequate records on a patient."

10 **ORDER**

11 Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law,

12 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 13 1. A letter of reprimand be issued to Dr. Bottiglione for the aforementioned
14 unprofessional conduct;
15 2. Dr. Bottiglione be put on Probation to complete twenty (20) hours of Board
16 staff-approved CME in record keeping within six (6) months, in addition to the CME
17 required for license renewal;
18 3. Dr. Bottiglione undergo an office review in six (6) months; and,
19 4. Dr. Bottiglione remain on Probation until the Board finds that he has
20 demonstrated completion of the required CME and the results of the office review are
21 satisfactory to the Board.

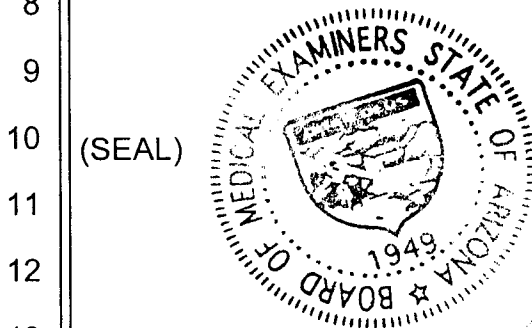
22 **RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REVIEW**

23 Dr. Bottiglione is hereby notified that he has the right to petition for a rehearing.
24 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09, as amended, the petition for rehearing must be filed with
25 the Board's Executive Director within thirty (30) days after service of this Order and

1 pursuant to A.A.C. R4-16-102, it must set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting a
2 rehearing. Service of this Order is effective five (5) days after the date of mailing. If a
3 motion for rehearing is not filed, the Board's Order becomes effective thirty-five (35) days
4 after it is mailed to Dr. Bottiglione.

5 Dr. Bottiglione is further notified that the filing of a petition for rehearing is required
6 to preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court that he may wish to pursue.
