CONSENT AGREEMENT

The parties mutually agree and understand that said Interim Order is issued pursuant to the Board Executive Director's authority at ALRLS. § 32-1405(C)(25).

This Consent Agreement for Interim Order arises cut of the Board's formal interview proceeding conducted on February 15, 2000, which was attended by Respondent and his attorney. During said formal intervier proceeding the parties mutually agreed to the terms and conditions of the Interim Order as setforth hereafter.

Respondent acknowledges that any violation of this interim Order constitutes unprofessional conduct within A.R.S. § 32-1401(25)(r), and may result in disciplinary action pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1451.

The parties mutually understand and agree that this interim Order does not constitute a final decision regarding the matters under investigation by the Board and referenced above by Board Investigation File No. 12677. Additionally, the acceptance of the Consent Agreement for Interim Order does not constitute as admission of misconduct

by Respondent; and the Interim Order shall not constitute a limal reportable disciplinary action by the Board, although this document in its entirety constitutes a public record document which may be disseminated to the extent required by law.

The Board is not limited in its exercise of its statutory authority by issuance of this order, unless expressly stated to the contrary. Furthermore, by signing this Consent Agreement, Respondent waives and relinquishes any right to expeal from or challenge this Interim Order by filing any type of administrative or judicial Assiew action.

Respondent acknowledges and agrees that, upon six hig this agreement, and returning this document (or a copy thereof) to the Board's Exe Size Director, Respondent may not revoke acceptance or make any modifications to the document, although said Agreement for Consent Order has not yet been accepted by lea Board or issued by the Executive Director. Any modifications to this Agreement for Companied Order are ineffective and void unless mutually approved by the parties.

Respondent expressly agrees and understands that the interim Order may be issued by the Board Executive Director, and is not subject to the Board final review and approval before becoming effective as an Interim Order.

Respondent shall comply with all terms and conditions a said Interim Order upon issuance by the Executive Director.


INTERIM ORDER
