







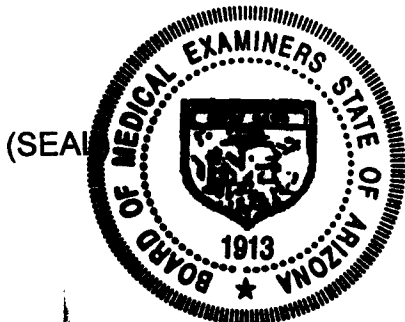
1 **RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REVIEW**

2 Respondent is hereby notified that she has the right to petition for a rehearing.  
3 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09, as amended, the petition for rehearing must be filed with  
4 the Board's Executive Director within thirty (30) days after service of this Order and  
5 pursuant to A.A.C. R4-16-102, it must set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting a  
6 rehearing. Service of this order is effective five (5) days after date of mailing. If a motion  
7 for rehearing is not filed, the Board's Order becomes effective thirty-five (35) days after it is  
8 mailed to Respondent.

9 Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for rehearing is required to  
10 preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
