**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
AND ORDER**

(Letter of Reprimand and Probation)

9 This matter was considered by the Arizona Board of Medical Examiners ("Board")
10 at its public meeting on October 11, 2001. Eugene Chandler, M.D., ("Respondent")
11 appeared before the Board with legal counsel, Daniel Jantsch, for a formal interview
12 pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by A.R.S. § 32-1451(I). After due
13 consideration of the facts and law applicable to this matter, the Board voted to issue the
14 following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order.

15 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 17 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of
18 the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.
 - 19 2. Respondent is the holder of License No. 7454 for the practice of medicine
20 in the State of Arizona.
 - 21 3. The Board initiated case number MD-99-0074 upon receiving a report from
22 the Phoenix Police Department that Respondent had been arrested.
 - 23 4. On September 29, 2000, after meeting with Board staff, Respondent signed
24 an Interim Consent Agreement for inpatient evaluation at Rush Behavioral Health in
25 Chicago ("Rush"). Respondent underwent the inpatient evaluation at Rush on October
25, 2000.

1 5. The evaluators at Rush recommended that Respondent undergo an MRI
2 and a neuropsychological examination. The evaluators also recommended that
3 Respondent cease practicing surgery until the recommended evaluations were complete
4 and the findings assessed.

5 6. Respondent refused to undergo the recommended evaluations in Chicago
6 and returned to Arizona. On November 17, 2000, during a follow-up interview with Board
7 staff, Respondent indicated that Rush had not informed him of the recommended
8 examinations; that he was reluctant to undergo the examinations at his own expense;
9 that he refused to accept the recommendation that he cease performing surgery until the
10 evaluations were completed and that he would not sign a consent agreement to submit to
11 the recommended evaluations if doing so would mean that he could not perform surgery.

12 7. On November 29, 2000, the Board received a copy of the history and
13 physical examination performed at Rush.

14 8. On December 15, 2000, the Board summarily suspended Respondent's
15 license and ordered the matter to formal hearing.

16 9. December 28, 2000, the Board received the results of the requested
17 neuropsychological evaluation. On January 2, 2001, the Board received the results of
18 the MRI. On January 14, 2001, the Board received the final report from Rush.

19 10. On March 2, 2001, the Board entered into an Interim Consent Agreement
20 ("Agreement") with Respondent. The Agreement provided that Respondent accept a
21 voluntary surrender of his license until he met with the Board and received Board
22 approval to return to practice; that the Summary Suspension was vacated; and that
23 Respondent undergo both a physical examination and a psychological/psychometric
24 evaluation and provide the results to the Board by May 11, 2001.
